## I Characteristics of God

- A Omnipresent (Psalms 139:7-12)
- B Omnipotent (Genesis 17:1)
- C Omniscient (Psalms 147:5)

## II Attributes of God

- A God Loves (John 3:16; Romans 5:6-8)
- B God is merciful or compassionate (James 5:11; Psalms 103:8)
- C God is gracious (Psalms 103:8; Psalms 86:15)
- D God is our help and strength and refuge (Psalms 46:1)
- E God is the giver of every good thing and perfect gift (James 1:17)
- F God is of all comfort (2 Corinthians 1:3,4)
- G God is true (John 17:3; 1 Thessalonians 1:9)
- H God is just and righteous (John 17:25; 1 Timothy 4:8)
- I God is a living God (Matthew 16:16; 2 Thessalonians 1:9)

## III Knowing God

- A We must be willing to seek God
  - 1 (Acts 17:27)—“seek God”
  - 2 (Hebrews 11:6)
- B We must be willing to serve God
  - 1 (Romans 12:1,2)
  - 2 (Exodus 23:25)
  - 3 In our service to God we must be willing to follow the commands of God (Deuteronomy 6:14, 15)
- C The Followers must be committed
  - 1 (Matthew 6:24)
- D If we want to know God we must follow His commands.
  - 1 (2 Timothy 3:16)

- B God wants us to come and know Him
  - 1 (Acts 17:30)
